
When we met through an artist friend, Gérald Vatrin shared his time between France, where he practiced the art of glass, and Mali, a country he has a strong emotional bond with. When he left Africa in the summer of 2014 due to political unrest, he had already been collaborating with the gallery for three years, as soon as it was founded in 2011. Back then, he showed mainly hybrid works that the public was able to discover during several exhibitions at the gallery and elsewhere. But his was already a rich artistic career. Linking the past with the present, weaving links with periods already covered by the gallery, that's what I suggest we discover.

His first steps were as follows: as a recent graduate from Cerfav, the European Centre for Research and Training in Glass Art in Vannes le Chatel in 1999, Gérald left for the South of France to join the International Research Centre for Glass and Fine arts, a.k.a. the CIRVA, in Marseilles. He put his technical skills to use and served many contemporary artists, and continued his path. The exhibition will tell this story. After this, he embarked on his first travels, as well as his Malian adventure, which we will not forget to mention.

After he withdrew to Nancy in 2014, his career started to bloom, including on an international level: the USA, China; soon Japan. Many of his pieces, have reached the New Continent in recent years via architects and interior designers, who seem very keen on these masterpieces. A little difficult to witness considering that it is still very rare to find glass lovers in Europe. Fortunately, European institutions are looking towards Vatrin and selecting some of his treasures deemed worthy of becoming cultural heritage: The Glass Museum of Carmaux in France, the Victoria & Albert Museum in London and the Glass Museum of Charleroi have just acquired a series of his works. This is most rewarding for this French artist with Anglo-Belgian roots who remembers where his home is: he is currently working on the renovation of the lights in Nancy's Villa Majorelle. He will also do us the pleasure of unveiling some previously unseen works.

It is therefore a great honor to present this personal exhibition which celebrates twenty years of creation and anticipates a focus that the Glass Museum in Charleroi will be dedicating to him next year. Save the date for October 21 2021 at the Bois du Cazier, and until then come and see us!

The exhibition comes with a catalogue comprising about fifty pieces, brilliantly lit by a text written by an aficionado and follower of both the gallery and the artist.
